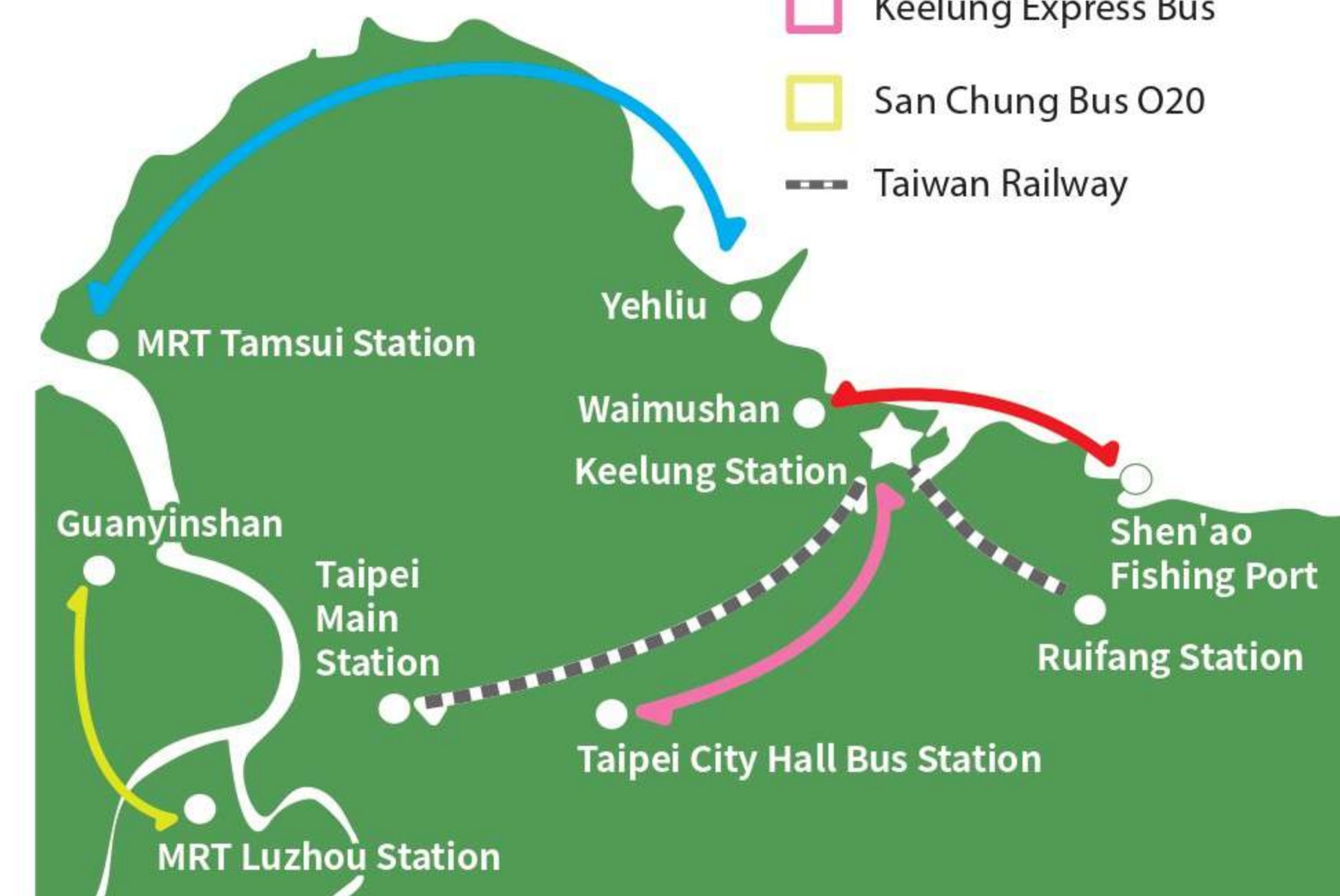

Take the MRT to Luzhou Station; transfer to San Chung bus O20 and get off at Lingyun Temple bus stop; from there it's a 20min. walk to the Guanyinshan Visitor Center.

Pay with an EasyCard or buy a 1-day pass on the bus (unlimited rides on day of purchase)

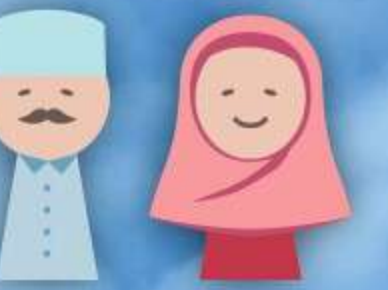

Guanyinshan Ecological Park

With functions of education and natural-environment conservation, this park has an ecological pond, raptor-viewing platform, the Linshao Trail, and other facilities. It is an outdoor experiential park where migratory birds can be seen heading back north every year.

Qianshui Bay

Qianshui Bay is a popular spot on the North Coast with a beautiful crescent white-sand beach. There are a number of cafés that serve good food in the area and many visitors come to watch the sunset while enjoying a good meal.

Shimen

Fugui Cape Park

In this park special geological sights can be viewed, including ventifacts, the Laomei Green Reefs, and sand dunes. The octagonal Fugui Cape Lighthouse with distinctive black and white stripes, is the northernmost lighthouse on main island Taiwan.



Baisha Bay

Baisha Bay is located between Fugui Cape and Linshanbi Cape. It is a natural half-moon shaped bay famed for its one-kilometer long winding white sandy beach. This is a popular place for bathing in the summer.

Jinshan



Jinbaoli Old Street

Jinbaoli Old Street has a history of more than 300 years. Since the Qing Dynasty it has been an important distribution center for the fishing industry on the North Coast. Among the local specialties sold by shops along this street with an old flair are sweet potatoes.



Shitoushan Park

Blessed with rich geological and natural ecological resources, Shitoushan is located on Jinshan Cape. Yeliu Cape can be seen to the east, Huanggang Fishing Harbor and Zhongjiao's mountain and sea scenery to the west, and the Twin Candlestick Islets to the north.

Yehliu Geopark

Yehliu Geopark, renowned for its strange rock formations, is a world-class attraction that should not be missed by visitors to northern Taiwan. Sea erosion and rock weathering over many years have turned this place into a strange-rock wonderland with geological features including weathered rock, sea-eroded gullies, sea-eroded cliffs and pot holes. The most famous formation is the Queen's Head Rock.

Heping Island Park

Heping Island is located on the eastern side of Keelung Harbor. Over time the northeastern monsoon and waves have created numerous strange rock formations here. There is a diverse sea-eroded landscape with tof rocks, sea-eroded trenches, sea-eroded caves, and mushroom rocks.
